



Crossroads-Connection is a Christian community service organization that provides a Weekend Food Program to food insecure children in the public schools of Haymarket and Gainesville. Our goal is to alleviate hunger as an obstruction to classroom learning by providing nutritious, easy to prepare and non-perishable meals. Sustained by faithful donors and volunteers from throughout the community, we operate as a chartered club of Heritage Hunt and a ministry of Shepherd of the Hills Lutheran Church. We welcome all who wish to support this very important mission.

The 2019-2020 School Year commitment is to serve 123 children; however, the need is much greater than what our current budget can support. It costs an average of \$256 to support a child for the 42 weeks of the school year; 100% of all donations goes toward the purchase of food. Schools supported are:

- Battlefield High School 6 students
- Buckland Mills Elementary 20 students
- Bull Run Middle School 12 students
- Glenkirk Elementary 2 students
- Gravely Elementary 14 students
- Mountain View Elementary 6 students
- Pace West Elementary 11 students
- Piney Branch Elementary 20 students
- Tyler Elementary 32 students

Shopping, Packing, & Delivery

- A team of volunteers shops bi-monthly at local stores;
- 15 – 20 volunteers gather each month in Heritage Hunt to pack the meals; and
- Volunteers deliver meals to the schools (during school hours) on a monthly basis.
